

# Key terms & concepts which appear throughout סדר נשים:

- קידוּשִׁין/אֵירוּסִין Engagement

#### Women

- בתוּלָה One who has never had relations before
- אלמנה Widow
- גְּרוּשָׁה Divorcee
- קטנה Under 12 years old
- נערה 12-12½ years old
- סיבוגרת Over 12½ years old

### When a man dies without children

- שבום When a man's brother dies and he has a mitzva to marry his wife
- חליצה What he does if he doesn't want to marry her, so that she may marry
- יבם The dead man's brother
- שוֹמֶּרֶת יָבָם / זקוקה / יבמה ה The dead man's wife (before she's had חַלִּיצָה / יַבּוּם)
- זיקה The bond which exists between the יָבָם and the שׁוֹמֶרֶת יָבָם
- מְאֶמֶר A מְאָמֶר engagement which should be done prior to יַבּוּם

- The document which a man gives his wife at the time of marriage and says that if she becomes divorced or widowed, she will receive payment

her children inherit מְדְרַבָּנָן דְּכְרִין - A woman's dowry which מְדְרַבָּנָן הַכְרִין her children inherit

- When a girl under מַּדְרַבָּנָן marriage which her mother and brothers had organised

אַיְלוֹנִית - A woman who is physically unable to give birth

ערוה - A relative whom it is forbidden to marry

- One born from relations which are punishable by פָּרַת

- One descended from the גְּבְעוֹנִים – a group who became servants of the Jews in the time of יְהוֹשֵׁעַן and may not marry into the Jewish people



## Key terms, concepts and rules in מסכת נדרים:

### **Rules:**

הַנְלֵל לָאוּ אַתָּה שׁוֹמֵעַ הַן - From a negative statement, we can deduce that the positive is true for the opposite situation.

אין שָׁבוּעָה חָלָה עַל שָׁבוּעָה - An oath is invalid if it goes against a previous oath.

בּדֶר שָׁהוּתַּר מִקְצָתוֹ הוּתַּר כּוּלוֹ - A vow is entirely invalid if part of it is invalid.

מְצְוּוֹת לָאוּ לֵיהָנוֹת נִיתְנוּ - Mitzvos weren't given to be a benefit, so one who is forbidden to have benefit from someone may benefit from his Mitzvos.

- When the status of an action becomes clarified and set retroactively after it takes place.

דָבָר שֶׁיֵשׁ לוֹ מַתִּירִין אַפִּילוּ בְּאֶלֶף לא בָּטֵל - Something which can become permitted in the future cannot be nullified in a mixture, e.g. if something belonging to the בֵּית can be redeemed then even if it's mixed up with 1000 permitted things, they don't cancel it out and they are all forbidden.

י מְחִית אִינָשׁ נַפְּשִׁיה לְּסְפֵיקָא - When one says something which could be interpreted in different ways, he intends only the most certain interpretation.

פל הנוֹדֶרֶת על דַעַת בַּעְלָה נוֹדֶרֶת • When a woman makes a vow, she intends that it only be valid if her husband approves.

- יד An incomplete גדר whose intention is clear
- כּינוּי A foreign language term meaning the same as a vow
- 📱 דָּבָר הָאָסוּר Something forbidden even without a נֶדֶר
- דָּבֶּר הַנְדוּר Something which becomes forbidden as a result of a גֶּדֶר, e.g. a קְרְבָּן, e.g. a

- לשון בְּנֵי אָדָם - The common meaning of something in people's language

(חַרְטָה) - A consequence of the נֶּדֶר which would've prevented him making it had he realised about it

י דְּבָרִים שֶׁבְּלֶב - One's intention which is thought but not expressed

- A group who converted to Judaism and whose Jewish status is debated

- A man who has not had a בָּרִית מִילָה

- חֵצֵר שֶׁאֵין בָּהּ דִין חַלוּקָה - A shared courtyard which is too small for one partner to force the other to buy it all or sell his share

- הְּחוֹם שֶׁבָּת From the edge of his city - אמות from the edge of his city

אַמוֹת  $70^2/_3$  - עִיבּוּר הָעִיר surrounding a city; it's considered part of the city - Until but not including

- An unlikely and unexpected occurrence

- View - Something which causes one suffering if deprived of it

- אַבְרִים שֶׁבֵּינוֹ לְבֵינָה - Something which affects the relationship of a husband and wife - פַּאַה/שָׁכְחַה/לֵקָט - Different gifts from one's field which must be given to the poor
