

Maseches Nedarim

- 1) An incomplete נֻדֵר whose intention is clear
- 2) A foreign language term meaning the same as a vow
- 3) A אָסוּר something which becomes אָסוּר as a result of someone's designation, e.g. קָרְבָּן
- 4) אַבוּעָה forbids the object ('חֵפְצָא'); a שְבוּעָה forbids the person (גַּבְרָא)
- נָדְרֵי זֶרוּזִין, הַבַּאי, שָׁגַגוֹת, אוֹנְסִין (5
- 6) It overrides שַׁבַּת
- 7) When the status of something becomes clarified after it takes place
- 8) If part of a נֵדֶר is invalid/cancelled/permitted, all of it is.
- 9) Mitzvos weren't given to be a benefit
- 10) The language which people speak and how people refer to things; what is forbidden by one's וֵדֵר is based on this
