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## *Maseches Nedarim*

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- 1) An incomplete נֶדֶר whose intention is clear
- 2) A foreign language term meaning the same as a vow
- 3) A דְּבַר הַנְּדוּר - something which becomes אָסוּר as a result of someone's designation, e.g. קֶרֶבּוּ
- 4) A נֶדֶר forbids the object ('הַפְּצָא'); a שְׂבוּעָה forbids the person (גְּבֻרָא)
- 5) נְדָרֵי זְרוּזִין, הַבְּאִי, שְׂגָגוֹת, אֹנְסִין
- 6) It overrides שְׁבֵת
- 7) When the status of something becomes clarified after it takes place
- 8) If part of a נֶדֶר is invalid/cancelled/permitted, all of it is.
- 9) Mitzvos weren't given to be a benefit
- 10) The language which people speak and how people refer to things; what is forbidden by one's נֶדֶר is based on this
