

Key terms & concepts which appear throughout סדר נשים:

- קידוּשִׁין/אֵירוּסִין Engagement

Women

- בתוּלָה One who has never had relations before
- אלמנה Widow
- גְּרוּשָׁה Divorcee
- קטנה Under 12 years old
- נערה 12-12½ years old
- סיבוגרת Over 12½ years old

When a man dies without children

- שבום When a man's brother dies and he has a mitzva to marry his wife
- חליצה What he does if he doesn't want to marry her, so that she may marry
- יבם The dead man's brother
- שוֹמֶּרֶת יָבָם / זקוקה / יבמה ה The dead man's wife (before she's had חַלִּיצָה / יַבּוּם)
- זיקה The bond which exists between the יָבָם and the שׁוֹמֶרֶת יָבָם
- מְאֶמֶר A מְאָמֶר engagement which should be done prior to יַבּוּם

- The document which a man gives his wife at the time of marriage and says that if she becomes divorced or widowed, she will receive payment

her children inherit מְדְרַבָּנָן דְּכְרִין - A woman's dowry which מְדְרַבָּנָן הַכְרִין her children inherit

- When a girl under מַּדְרַבָּנָן marriage which her mother and brothers had organised

אַיְלוֹנִית - A woman who is physically unable to give birth

ערוה - A relative whom it is forbidden to marry

- One born from relations which are punishable by פָּרַת

- One descended from the גְּבְעוֹנִים – a group who became servants of the Jews in the time of יְהוֹשֵׁעַן and may not marry into the Jewish people



Key terms, concepts and rules in מסכת סוטה:

Rules:

- **גַזִּירָה שְׁוָוה** • When the same root of a word is found in 2 different פסוקים and a law is therefore learnt from one and applied to the other.

י פְּטֶר הָעוֹמֵד לְגְבּוֹת כְּגָבוּי דָּמִי - If a document says that someone owes another person money, it's considered as if the money has been collected already if it's guaranteed to be collected, i.e. if it includes an אחריות נכסים – the right to collect from property which the debtor has sold in a case where he doesn't have enough money.

- One who is trying to take something from someone else must prove that he is entitled to it..

אָפְשָׁר לְצַמְצֵם - The Halacha can rely upon precise measurement and human error doesn't need to be taken into account.

Concepts and Terms:

- 1. קינוי When a man warns his wife not to be alone with a certain other man
- 2. סְתִּירָה When a woman ignores her husband's warning and is alone with the man
- 3. טומאה When a woman has relations with another man

- **מְחוּסְרֵי כּפְּרָה** - Those people who have purified themselves from being טמא but may only eat קְרָבָּנוֹת after they've brought their קְרָבָּן

use בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ - A gold/silver utensil sanctified for בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ

אָלְגוּל שְׁבוּעָה - When one is obligated to swear about something, he can be made to swear about other things about which he wouldn't otherwise be obligated to swear.

- י קְּנוּפָה Waving a קְרְבָּן in all directions
- הַגָּשָׁה towards the מְזְבֵּחַ towards the מְזְבֵּח
- קְמִיצָה Taking a 3-finger handful of flour from a קְרָבַּן מִנְחָה
- מְזָבֵּחַ Burning (that flour) on the מְזָבֵּח
- קְדוּשַׁת הַגּוּף When something is itself sanctified for the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ
- קדוּשַׁת דָּמִים When the value of something is sanctified for the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ

ים - 'On that day' – referring to the day when ר' אלעזר בן עזריה took over from סַנְהֶּדְרִין as the נָשִּׂיא – head of סַנְהֶּדְרִין

- יְשַׂרָאֵל Food which may be eaten by anyone, even a יָשַׂרָאֵל
- יידוי הַמְּעֲשֵׂר The declaration that one has given all the requisite gifts from his produce
- דְמָאי Food about which it's unknown whether the requisite gifts have been set aside

- קְּחוּם שֶׁבָּת from the edge of his city שַׁבָּת from the edge of his city אַמוֹת 2000

- When everybody gathers in the בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ on the first night of חוֹל הַמוֹעֵד on the first night of בֵּית הַמִּקְדָּשׁ פּוּכּוֹת after a שְׁמִיטָה year and the King leins in front of them

עגְלָה ערוּפָה - Breaking a calf's neck when a murdered man's body is found outside a city and the murderer is unknown

י מּהֵן מְשׁוּח מִּלְחָמָה - The anointed כּהֵן who would speak to and strengthen the Jews before battle

ייְרְחָא דְּצִיבּוּרָא - Bothering the congregation by making them wait; this is avoided

- מְלְחֶמֶת הָרְשׁוּת A war which isn't obligatory upon the Jewish people
- מְלְחֶמֶת מִצְוָה A war which is obligatory upon the Jewish people
