- 1) A co-wife
- 2) No, because one is forbidden to marry his brother's wife. It's only permitted as יָבּוּם because עַשֵּׂה דוֹחֶה לא תַּעֲשֶׂה one עַשֵּׂה בוֹחָה a positive commandment overrides a negative one
- 3) When a girl under מִדְרַבְּנָן who was married מִדְרַבְּנָן cancels the marriage
- 4) A חֵרֵשׁ (deaf-mute); a קָטָן
- 5) She must get חַלִּיצָה to fulfil the חִיוּב דְרַבְּנָן, and can't get יִבּוּם because she is exempt מְדְאוֹרֵיִיתָא
